- **Back To School Night:** Back To School Night will be held on Wednesday, September 7th from 6:30 p.m.-7:30 p.m. This is the opportunity to obtain specific information from your child's teacher(s). There will not be an all school address this year. However, the leadership team will be on-site to answer any questions. Classroom teachers will conduct three 20 min. sessions as follows:

Session One: 6:30-6:50
Session Two: 6:50-7:10
Session Three: 7:10-7:30
- **Labor Day:** There will be NO school on Monday, September 5th due to Labor Day. May you enjoy this time with family and friends.
- **NWEA and MClass:** MClass assessments will begin the week of September 6th for Kdg. and 1st. grade. NWEA will begin the week of September 12th for grades 2-7. MClass is a diagnostic assessment delivered in a one on one setting to students in order to gauge reading and math skills. NWEA is a computerized assessment which provides information about how students are achieving in the areas of Reading, Math, and Language Arts.
- **Powerschool:** Discovery parents are able to access grades through our database. Parent letters with access links will be going home on Friday, September 9th.
- **Substitute Teachers:** We are currently accepting applications for individuals interested in substitute teaching. If you or anyone you know are interested, please e-mail a resume to kpoplawski@aq.s.org. Interested applicants must hold a valid Teacher's License OR be eligible to apply for a Substitute Teacher License (Hold a bachelor's degree OR 60 hours undergraduate credit hours.)

We are asking individuals NOT to park in the small lot immediately adjacent to the playground as students do use that small lot for recess space. **Parents and visitors may park in the main lot between 7:30-2:30.
